Degree programme in Nursing 17M, part-time studies

Spring 2017 starts part-time studies in nursing. In Lahti University of Applied Sciences the structure of the curriculum is as follows:

Basic studies, professional studies, clinical studies (75 ECTS), thesis (15 ECTS), and complementary studies (30 ECTS), which include elective studies (15 ECTS).

The curriculum is module based, which each are 30 ECTS. Each module include 5-15 ECTS courses.

The focus in this degree programme is in good client centered care. The studies focus on the different age, acutely and chronically ill clients in nursing care. Central themes are clinical nursing, decision-making, supervisory and teaching skills, ethics and professionalism, the promotion of health and functional capacity, management and entrepreneurship.

On successful completion of this module, you will be able to describe the scientific underpinnings of nursing practice and the basis of health and disorders. You will have grasped the basics of professional communication and how to search for reliable data in your field, you will have to ability to develop your critical thinking skills and understand the role of multidisciplinary knowledge as the underlying basis of the vocational learning process. In addition, you will be able to describe the basics of human anatomy and physiology, carry out monitoring of vital functions, and deliver customer-oriented and ethically sound

basic care and safe pharmacotherapy as part of the broader concept of good care.

STSH17M-1005 Good chronic care: 20 ECTS

Learning outcomes of the study module

By the end of this module, you will be familiar with the concept of good nursing care of patients with chronic illnesses. You will be able to deliver good clinical care for patients with common chronic illnesses, recognise the boundaries of your personal competencies and vocational area of responsibility, and understand the nurse's contribution in evidence-based practice. You will have grasped the principles of evidence-based, customer-oriented guidance of patients/customers, of supporting the customer's active role, and the use of an empowering work approach in a good care process. You will be able to recognise risks related to patient safety and different risk management approaches, identify risks related to health, work capacity and impairments, health promotion methods and good care of patients/customers as part of the continuity of care.

08HYPS1 Competence in chronic nursing care: 5 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- name the risk factors of common chronic diseases and conditions and the associated symptoms and care, using evidence-based knowledge
- perform safe pharmacotherapy and dosage calculations
- carry out the main types of examination and care procedures related to the care of a chronic patient/customer and provide guidance
- explain the roles of a work approach that promotes functional ability, and of the multidisciplinary team and families in the care of chronically ill patients/customers

ST00AX20 Competence in mental health and substance abuse work 5: 5 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- recognise the role of their own personality and ethical practice in the care relationship, reflect on their thought processes and see supervision as a support function of their professional practice
- describe characteristics specific to the care relationship in mental health and substance abuse treatment, plan and evaluate the delivery of care using evidence-based knowledge
- describe legislation governing mental health work in social and health care, health policy programmes and the substance abuse and mental health service system
- describe the role of safe pharmacotherapy as part of the overall care of mental health and substance abuse patients, taking into account the special requirements of mental health and substance abuse work
- describe the roles of a team, multidisciplinary approach and network-based practice in the holistic care of a patient

- name basic concepts and models of rehabilitation and justify the rehabilitative nursing approach in different settings

- describe and use basic concepts of public health science and epidemiology and use different types of reliable sources to describe the state of public health
 - explain how the methods of social and health care as well as health policy can influence the health of the population and demographic groups
 - describe the etiology and prevention of common psychological and physical disorders and the primary methods of medicine and health sciences in their treatment
 - use pharmacological concepts, name drug groups and describe their effects and side effects
- Areas of medicine: public health science, internal medicine, pathology, psychiatry

STSH17M-1006 Good care in acute care: 20 ECTS

Learning outcomes of the study module

In this module, you will familiarise yourself with the concept of good acute care. By the end of this module, you will be able to plan, deliver and appraise good nursing care of patients with an acute illness and/or in perioperative nursing in different practice settings. You will be able to interact with patients and their families with a holistic approach in demanding care situations. In addition, you will be able to apply evidence-based knowledge, such as instructions on patient care and examination, clinical guidelines and best practices, in nursing situations requiring problem-solving and decision-making skills. You will be equipped to provide safe care with due regard for patient safety and security as well as occupational safety and health. You will be able to work in multidisciplinary teams and analyse your actions and those of the team.

08HAKU1 Good acute care: 5 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- describe the different stages of the care process of patients with an acute physical and or psychological condition in different environments
- monitor and assess the state and vital functions of acute patients and recognise the most common types of abnormalities
- apply the principles of safe pharmacological, fluid, nutrition and pain therapies in acute nursing care
- apply evidence-based knowledge in the planning, delivery and appraisal of nursing care with acute patients
- identify patients in crisis and apply the basic principles of psychological intervention in the patient's care

ST00AX21 Critical thinking and problem-solving skills: 5 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- * analyse, from the point of view of critical thinking, various complex and ethically challenging situations in patient care
- * draw conclusions and identify evidence-based solutions to problems in various acute care situations and apply knowledge in the planning of a patient's care
- analyse and assess factors related to patient safety and security in the nursing care of acute patients

08HAKU3 Interaction and guidance skills: 5 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- use different methods of health promotion and guidance as a professional tool in different stages of patients' treatment paths with individual patients/customers and their families or with groups
- guide and interact with patients/customers in electronic communication environments
- analyse the starting points of dialogic encounters with patients, patient engagement, commitment and self-management and different support methods in multidisciplinary cooperation

08HAKU4 Medical competence 3: 5 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- use the terminology of different specialties and describe the primary research and treatment methods and processes of a specialty (surgery, anaesthesiology, gynaecology and obstetrics, paediatrics, infectious diseases, geriatrics)

STSH17M-1007 Good nursing care in different life stages: 15 ECTS

Learning outcomes of the study module

In this module, students explore the topic of good nursing care in different life stages. By the end of

this module, you should have the necessary theoretical knowledge and skills in family nursing care to interact with and care for different types of patients/customers and their families. The courses of this module are integrated around the life span approach, and you will learn to examine the life circumstances of individuals and families from this perspective. On successful completion of this module, you will be able to design, deliver and appraise good nursing care of children, young people and families and support the well-being of families with young children. In addition, you will be able to examine the characteristics specific to the nursing care of the elderly and respond with appropriate care in different settings, drawing from evidence-based knowledge. The module includes Swedish language studies which will enable you to interact with Swedish-speaking customers of different ages.

ST00AX19 Family nursing care: 2 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- apply family nursing methods to support customers and describe the principles of personal resource-oriented guidance and care
- support the well-being of expecting and new families
- describe the development of early interaction by utilising theory

ST00AX18 Children's and young people's nursing care: 5 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- describe child's and adolescent's growth and development and apply knowledge in nursing practice
- assess changes in a child's condition: monitor the child's condition, interpret the observations and provide care in cooperation with the child's family and other professionals
- identify the requirements of safe pharmacotherapy and fluid therapy
- apply evidence-based knowledge in the recognition and treatment of a child's pain
- demonstrate understanding of the concept of child abuse and awareness of the procedures under the Child Welfare Act and of the family intervention methods available

08ELVA3 Elderly nursing care: 5 ECTS

Learning outcomes

Students will be able to

- explain common effects of ageing on health and everyday coping capacity
- assess, support and promote the wide-ranging functional ability of elderly customers and their families, using a wide range of promoting methods
- describe the characteristics of pharmacotherapy specific to elderly patients and apply knowledge to deliver pharmacotherapy safely
- evaluate the characteristics of older people from different cultures, patients with severe dementia and ageing disabled people in encountering death and the associated end-of-life care
- design a multidisciplinary rehabilitation process for an elderly patient and utilise the rehabilitation service system

- read and analyse clear, jargon-free texts of the field of interest
- produce simple, logical factual text related to the field of interest

You will be able to apply research and development methodology towards the renewal and regeneration of well-being services in professional practice. You will also be able to apply the principles of ethical and sustainable development in well-being services development.
